



Northwest United FC Refund and Prorated Fee Policy

Club Tuition for the Northwest United FC 2021-22 Season:

- U9-U10 Tuition: \$895 (\$175 non-refundable registration payment and 8 installments of \$90)
- U11-U12 Tuition: \$1,295 (\$175 non-refundable registration payment and 8 installments of \$140)
- U13-U18 Tuition: \$1,495 (\$175 non-refundable registration payment and 8 installments of \$165)

NWU tuition can be broken up into 3 sessions.

- U9-U14 age groups play a summer session, fall session, and spring session.
- U15-U19 girls play a summer session, winter session, and spring session (fall break for high school soccer).
- U15-U19 boys play a summer session, fall session, and winter session (spring break for high school soccer).

The cost of each session is 3 installments. (Note that the first installment is always the \$175 registration fee.)

Refund Policy

A refund will be issued when a player's payments have exceeded the cost of Northwest United FC tuition for the period of time the player participated. For example, if a U13 player participates in summer & fall sessions (cost of 2 sessions is 6 installments) and makes 7 payments (1 payment of \$175 and 6 payments of \$165) totaling \$1165, the player is due a refund in the amount of \$165. If a player participates in a partial session, the NWU Bookkeeper will calculate a refund depending on how much of the session the player participated in.

Prorated Fee Policy

Much like the Refund Policy, if a player joins late in the year, he/she will only be required to pay for the time he/she participates on a team. Players will pay for the sessions in which they participate. For example, if a U12 player joins the club after the summer session is over, that player will owe 6 installments (1 payment of \$175 and 5 payments of \$140) totaling \$875. If a player joins mid-way through a session, the NWU Bookkeeper will calculate a proration depending on how much of the session the player participated in.
